God has been good! We have several things we are asking you to pray about in the coming weeks. Many new legal requirements are necessary to reenter the country, and we are currently

working on these during the short visit we have with our daughter's family in the Seattle area. We will be required to have various legal documents in hand, along with apps on our phones to allow us to be "tracked" during the quarantine process we'll be following. (Three days in a government facility and ten days in mission housing.) Please pray with us that:

#1: All of our documentation will be completed correctly in the time remaining, and will be accepted as we leave the

States, and also as we enter Japan. #2: Please pray that in the 72-hours prior to boarding, our CoVid tests will both be "negative." Pray that we'll also test

"negative" after our arrival in Japan. #3: Pray for wisdom and clarity in all that's happening during these new procedures.

#4: Pray for fully funded missionaries, waiting for the borders to reopen and their visas to be processed.

#5: Please continue to pray for the Japan churches, for the pastors, Christians and missionaries continuing to spread the Good News during these challenging times.

#6: Pray for Judy's 93-yr. old father, Rev. Emer Turnbough,

who entered Assisted Living shortly before we left MO in late


