Bangladesh

Bangladesh Partnership - Please pray for the political situation in Bangladesh. Last year the government that had been in power for many years fell as they tried to squelch student demonstrations, killing hundreds of students in the process. A caretaker-government is in place, and elections have been set for February 12th. However, in recent weeks, radical Muslims have been stirring things up rallying mobs that are attacking Hindus and Christians. Please pray that the current government will manage to keep things under control, that elections will take place, and that a new government can bring stability and peace to the country. Pray for new church planting projects that are scheduled to begin this month.

Brazil

Brazil Partnership - Pray for three of our pastors as they begin fundraising to go on a missions trip to Tajikistan later this year. They were invited for the second time by our partners there to conduct soccer camps as an opportunity for evangelistic outreach.

Bulgaria
