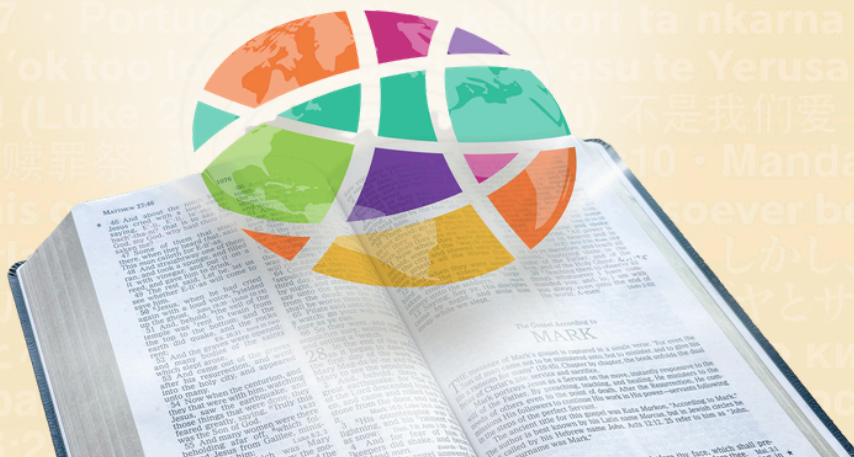

## ► **Scripture:** Ephesians 4:1-3

“I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

**(KJV)**

“I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.” **(ESV)**

## ► **Focus: PATIENCE** as we wait on the Lord.

# ADULTS

## ▶ **Memorize Scripture:** Ephesians 4:1-3

Spend the time writing down the three verses (KJV or ESV) to work towards memorization. After a week or two, see what you remember.

## ▶ **Devotion:**

Have you ever wanted something so bad that you could hardly wait? A special vacation, a new job starting, waiting for your special wedding day, or your retirement? Maybe it's waiting on the Lord to answer a prayer you've prayed for years.

Sometimes we are so busy waiting for something to happen in the future, and we miss the moments of today. When things don't happen as quickly as we want, we begin to neglect to see what the Lord has for us now. Ask the Lord to help you to be humble, gentle, patient, and for Him to show the fruit in us as we wait.

## ▶ **Prayer:**

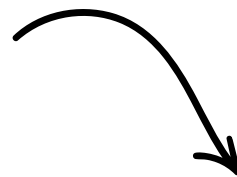
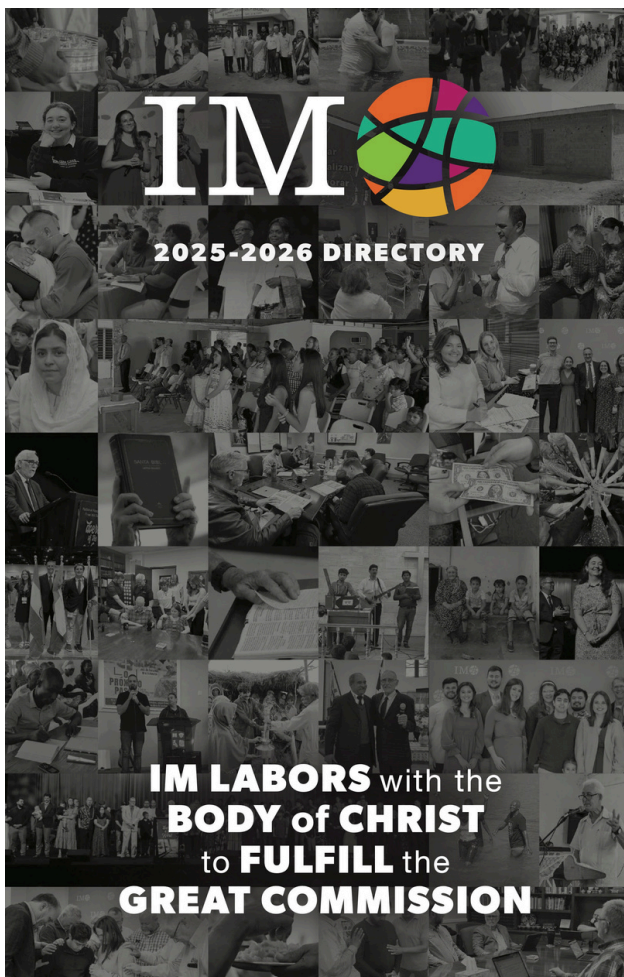
We have many missionaries who are Stateside raising funds and support to get to their fields. They spent a lot of time traveling, visiting different churches, and meeting with "hopeful" supporters. Pray for their patience and the Lord's timing. Pray specifically for their families and friends, as some say "see you later" for a season as missionaries leaving for their terms on the field.

Whether they are career missionaries or new individuals starting out, lift them up before our Father, who knows their specific needs. Ask your pastor if missionaries can visit your church so you can hear firsthand what they are doing, and for you and your family to get to know them.

## ► Activity:

Choose four missionaries to specifically pray for this month and get their contact information from the **IM Directory** (Scan the QR code below or visit the IM website: <https://iminc.org/digital-resources/>), and then email them. Ask them how they are doing and find out specific prayer requests. Learn more about their ministries and the place they are serving. This helps you pray more effectively. Invite your children into this activity. If you are doing this corporately as a church, what a unifying time this would be for each person to share the different missionaries you've contacted and ways to pray together.

# TEENS/YOUTH

## ▶ **Memorize Scripture:** Ephesians 4:1-3

Write these three verses down daily this month. They are packed with how you ought to react to life every day.

## ▶ **Devotion:**

You know how it is ... saving up money for that special something you've wanted. Maybe a new phone or laptop. That special outfit for a school function. How about ETEAM or Truth and Peace fundraising?

You set a goal to try to reach it, but it takes patience! Just like our missionaries that are in the United States right now raising money to go to the other parts of the world, it takes patience and trust.

Ephesians 4:1-3 says that we should walk in a manner worthy of our calling. Our missionaries have been called, but you have been called too, to walk in humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

That sounds like a lot, but that's where **patience** comes in. Be patient, be in the Word, memorize Scripture, keep the peace, especially when it's hard, and be humble.

We walk in this calling of Ephesians 4:1-3 day by day and moment by moment. Remember, when it gets difficult or you find yourself in tense situations, just breathe and call on His Name, Jesus.

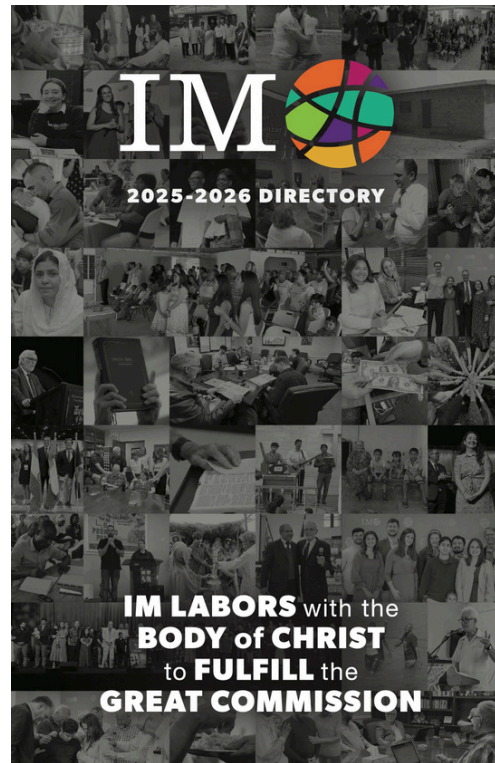
# TEENS/YOUTH

## ► Prayer:

Go to your missionary prayer card set and choose four new missionaries for March. If they have teenagers, reach out to their parents via email by using the **IM Directory** (Scan the QR code or visit:

<https://iminc.org/digital-resources/>) and see if you can contact them.

(Always get permission from your parents first!) If they are Stateside, ask them how the fundraising is going, what they are looking forward to in their country, and how school is for them as they travel to raise money. Once you find out, you can begin to pray specifically for them.



## ► Activity:



For a craft, either for family or for Sunday School, make bracelets by purchasing some string at the store in the craft section. Buy some beads with letters on them so you can spell out any of the words in our verses this month: humility, gentleness, patience, love, peace. These inexpensive items can also be ordered from Amazon. Gift them to a friend or family member, or wear the bracelet as a reminder of how you are to live as a believer.

# KIDS

## ➤ **Memorize Scripture:** Ephesians 4:1-3

Our verses this month remind us to “Walk worthy...with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love...in the bond of peace.” Can you memorize one of these verses this month? Ask for help to say or write them every day, and you’ll have them memorized in no time!

## ➤ **Devotion:**

Waiting for your turn, waiting for something you want, waiting to go to that theme park—waiting is hard! Do you know that we have missionaries who are ready to go to other countries, but they are waiting? What are they waiting for? They’re waiting on the Lord to provide the money, paperwork, or support needed so they can go. That’s why it is so important to pray for them and give to them.

## ➤ **Prayer:**

We never have to wait to pray. We can pray at any moment, in any place, during any situation. Jesus always hears us, and He loves it when we pray that people will provide support for our missionaries to GO where they are called!

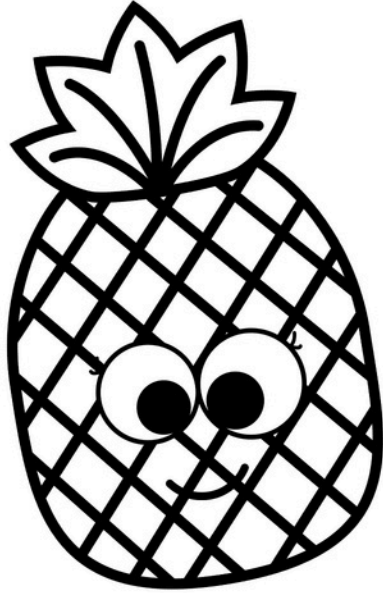
## ➤ **Activities:**

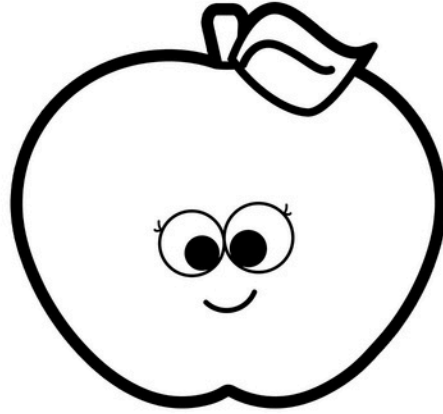
