

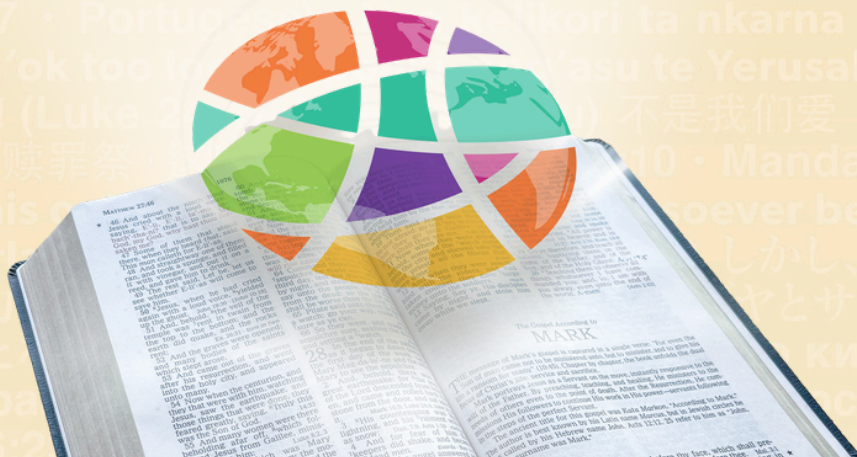

► **Scripture:** 2 Timothy 1:2-5

“To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. I thank God, whom I serve from my forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day; greatly desiring to see thee, being mindful of thy tears, that I may be filled with joy; when I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.”

(KJV)

“To Timothy, my beloved child; Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. I thank God whom I serve as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy. I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well.”

► **Focus: Give, Pray, Send, Go**

ADULTS

► **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Timothy 1:2-5

Memorize Scripture: Although we have four verses to memorize this month, they flow well and give us a glimpse into Paul's feelings for Timothy. It's a personal letter, but not a private letter, as it was intended to be read to the church. How exciting that we are passing our faith on to the next generation!

► **Devotion:**

I'm reminded this month of pioneer missionary Ken Eagleton Senior. As he was nearing the end of his time in Brazil, he was convicted to see young people experiencing missions in other countries.

Because of that conviction, ETEAM was formed. High school students, and now college students through our College Missions Program (CMP), can serve anywhere from a few weeks to a couple of months with our current IM missionaries and partners on the field.

In the Bible, Paul spoke lovingly of Timothy and his grandmother, Lois, and mother, Eunice. They were willing to let Timothy go.

Like Lois and Eunice, let's pray together for the students who are involved this year in ETEAM and CMP. They've raised their financial support, and now we pray for God to move in their hearts as they serve Him in their respective countries.

Pray their vision for the world will expand as they experience missionary life first-hand. Only eternity will know the impact of their service. Pray for the missionaries they work with and the people they interact with. Once they return home, we pray God will continue to work in their lives, not only to be a witness where they live, but maybe as career IM missionaries one day.

ADULTS

► Prayer:

This month, we want to take time to be faithful to pray for these students, to pray for their parents, and to pray for the missionaries and partners with whom they will be serving alongside. Like Paul, let us pray for them day and night. And perhaps the Lord is placing a reminder on your heart that your children or grandchildren might one day also take the Gospel to others around the world.

► Activity:

If you're on Facebook, make sure you subscribe to the pages of ETEAM Student Mission Program and also College Missions Program at IM, Inc. You'll find ways to specifically pray for the students – the ways they will serve and the people they will minister to. Share this with your family and your church, and remember as we **GIVE, PRAY, SEND, GO.**

We want to encourage you to download the **IM Student Missions Prayer Calendar** and hang each month's sheet on your refrigerator, or somewhere where your whole family can see it, so you can be reminded of the global impact your family has as you partner with these students in prayer while they minister to people in various fields around the world.

TEENS/YOUTH

► **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Timothy 1:2-5

There are several verses to memorize this month. Try to memorize one verse every three days and then spend the rest of the month repeating the verses together.

► **Devotion:**

Paul mentions in our verses about the faith of Timothy, which began first with his grandmother Lois and mother Eunice. We're going to turn the tables this month and ask you to think about your parents and thank them for the many ways they share Christ with you. They've brought you up in church, take you to all the activities, and are always there for you in your walk with Christ. Tell them you appreciate their willingness to do what it takes to keep your faith strong. Remember, they're your number one fans! And if not your parents, we know that God has placed Godly adults in your life who help you walk your faith.

Next, we want you to pray all month for the teens and college students who are leaving NOW for ETEAM and College Missions Programs. They've raised their money, they're packing their bags, and they're going to serve all over the world.

► **Prayer:**

Do you know a teen or college student who is going overseas or on a missions trip this summer? Pray for them every day. If you don't know someone in particular, you can still pray for the collective group of students each day. Pray for travels, safety, pray for them as they serve others, and pray for the missionaries and partners they are serving alongside. Your prayer list this month can be long, but know that your prayers are needed and are so vital for building God's Kingdom.

TEENS/YOUTH

► Activity:

This month, we want you to begin praying about whether God would allow you to be a part of ETEAM or the College Missions Program (CMP) next year. As you pray throughout the month for your peers, pray for God's plan in your life. And then we want you to look at the application form on the IM website and pray about it (high school students who have completed 9th grade can apply for the following summer's opportunities). God can use you in so many ways, and we would love for you to be a partners with us. As you're praying, check out the IM Student Missions Prayer Calendar, which shows where these students will be serving.

KIDS

▶ **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Timothy 1:3

Can you memorize this verse this month? It's a good one because it reminds us to pray day and night for others. Let's try to memorize this verse: "I thank God whom I serve as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day." (ESV)

▶ **Devotion:**

The Apostle Paul was praying for young Timothy. In many ways, Paul was like a father to Timothy. If you'll read on down through verse five, Paul mentions that Timothy's faith was built on the faith of his grandmother Lois and mother Eunice. Aren't we so glad that we have parents and grandparents who help us walk closely with God? Tell them how thankful you are for them.

▶ **Prayer:**

This month, many teenagers are headed off to other countries through our ETEAM program. They will be working with our missionaries and partners in places all over the world. Won't you pray for them day and night throughout June? Pray for their safety, pray as they work with our missionaries and partners, and pray as they share Christ with other people. And guess what? It won't be long before you'll be able to serve through our ETEAM program!

KIDS

Activity:

Let's make these Hand Prayer Reminders (example and link are shown on the next page) to get us praying daily for those teens who are going to serve in the month of June. You might do this as a family, or you could ask your Sunday School teacher if this is an activity you can buy online from Etsy. An alternative idea is to trace your own hand on a piece of paper and list the countries where ETEAMS are going to serve this month (Reference the **IM Student Missions Prayer Calendar** as a guide). To fill all "fingers", use Pray for Safety, Pray for Serving, etc.
