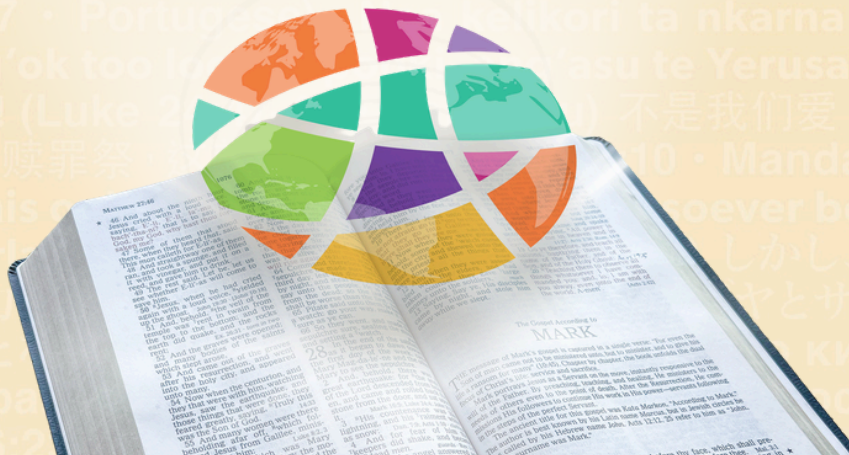

► **Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 1:6-7

“And whether we be afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in the enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer: or whether we be comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. And our hope of you is steadfast, knowing that as ye are partakers of the sufferings, so shall ye be also of the consolation.”

(KJV)

“If we are afflicted, it is for your comfort and salvation; and if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which you experience when you patiently endure the same sufferings that we suffer. Our hope for you is unshaken, for we know that as you share in our sufferings, you will also share in our comfort.”

► **Focus: Partners Together**

ADULTS

▶ **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 1:6-7

Spend time writing down the two verses (KJV or ESV) to work towards memorization. After a week or two, see what you remember.

▶ **Devotion:**

Children are so transparent. We know they don't like to share. If we admit it to ourselves, we don't really like to share either. I would really like the bigger piece of cake; I'd rather use this money to buy this or that instead of giving. We can all struggle with selfish motives.

Our verses this month encourage us to share in the afflictions of others – afflictions that come with knowing Christ. That is how we connect with believers wherever they are. We are blessed as Free Will Baptists to have global partnerships around the world.

Believers who want to partner with our denomination to promote and share in places where we do not have missionaries.

▶ **Prayer:**

This month, we want to take time to praise the Lord for the far-reaching ministries of IM Global Partners! Pray for their boldness to continue sharing the Gospel in areas like India, Pakistan, and Bangladesh, which can be dangerous for Christians. For we know that our Hope is unshaken and steadfast! Pray for financial provision to these partnerships as they carry out their many ministries, carrying the Gospel even further.

ADULTS

► Activity:

As we partner together with our partners in countries around the world who face persecution, need our prayers, and are seeking financial partnership to continue their ministries, here is a simple way your family can partner with them from “home.”

Pick one night a week at dinner to have each family member draw a different country and pause to specifically pray for our partners and the believers in that country throughout the month of May.

TEENS/YOUTH

► **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 1:6-7

Are you still memorizing Scripture? At the end of this month, you'll have several verses that you can recite from memory. Way to go!

► **Devotion:**

Because many of us live freely in a country that lets us worship, we may not realize how the Gospel is being opposed in other countries. We do not have missionaries in every part of the world, but we do have many partnerships that work together with IM through several ministries expanding the reach of the Gospel, even in areas where they face persecution.

Have you ever imagined what it would be like to feel persecuted or outcast because of your beliefs? This is a reality for many Free Will Baptist believers in countries like India, Pakistan, and Bangladesh.

► **Prayer:**

Our Scriptures this month tell us to share in the afflictions of our partnerships. Pray for them in their persecution to continue being bold in sharing the Gospel despite the fears they face. Pray also for them in their joy as others come to know Christ, are baptized, and are being discipled.

TEENS/YOUTH

► Activity:

To build on our activity with IM Global Partners last month, visit the webpage (or scan the QR code below) again to read about the ministry efforts in their field and how you can pray. Cut strips of paper and each week, write a country name and a specific, but brief, prayer request to correspond with that country on the strip of paper. As you create each prayer request strip, these become your **“prayer chain links,”** so at the end of the month, you can link them all together into a chain and hang it up as a reminder to partner in prayer with our partners who are reaching many people with the Gospel.

KIDS

► **Memorize Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 1:7

Are you still memorizing Scripture? This is a wonderful verse to repeat to yourself all throughout the month. Can you write it out once a day – every day – this month? You’ll have it memorized in no time!

► **Devotion:**

II Corinthians 1:7 (ESV) tells us, “Our hope for you is unshaken, for we know that as you share in our sufferings, you will also share in our comfort.” Have you ever felt sad when a friend was hurting? Have you ever felt excited when something good happened to them? That is what it means to care for one another. As Christians, we are one family in Jesus. Believers all around the world are part of God’s family, too. When they are hurting, we can pray for them. When they have joy, we can celebrate with them. No matter where we live, we are all connected as the Body of Christ through faith in Jesus.

► **Prayer:**

Remember our Global Partners from last month and our downloadable sheets? We’re going to continue to pray for them this month because we have so many and we can never pray too much for them! Have your parents help you find [IM Global Partners](http://www.iminc.org) listed on the IM website (www.iminc.org) to see the different IM partnerships and ministries. You’ll find many IM partners who are teaching others about Jesus. Many of them serve in places where it might be dangerous to worship God. And while we are so glad we have the freedom to worship here in America, we need to pray for those that are struggling and having a hard time worshipping. In the same way, we can be so happy when we hear that many have accepted Christ as their Savior. The more we know, the more we can pray and then rejoice!
