

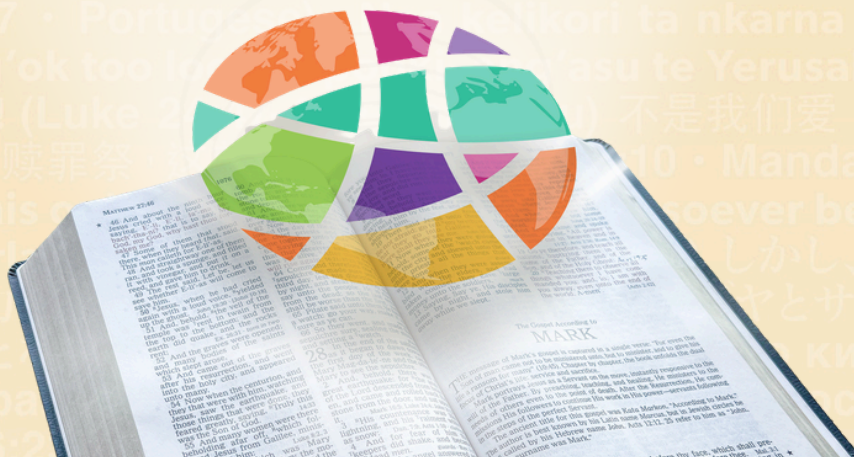

► **Scripture:** Matthew 28:18-20

“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, ‘All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.’”

(KJV)

“And Jesus came and said to them, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. ► **Focus:** Commissioned

ADULTS

➤ **Memorize Scripture:** Matthew 28:18-20

These three verses may be Scripture that you have already memorized, but let's go deeper into what Jesus is "commanding" us to do as believers. We know that we don't have to do it alone because the Holy Spirit is willing and able to help us. Teach these verses to your children and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to whom you can share the Good News.

➤ **Devotion:**

Commissioned means formally authorized, ordered, or appointed to perform a specific task or produce a piece of work. If you've ever attended a Wednesday night service at the Free Will Baptist National Convention, you've seen firsthand how God moves among His people as we answer "Yes, we will" when asked to support our newly commissioned missionaries through prayer. They have been called by our Savior and have answered His calling on their lives for a very specific ministry. It's a very powerful evening each year!

The Great Commission found in the New Testament is not just for the missionaries. It's for us here as well. We are commanded to make disciples of all nations, to teach and to baptize. As we look in our neighborhoods and cities, we see the nations are coming to us. What an opportunity!

Pray for the National Convention taking place in Columbus, Ohio, on July 19-22. The theme for 2026 is FOCUS, and during the Wednesday evening service, our newest missionaries will be commissioned to go out and serve. Pray that others attending will feel the call to one day go as missionaries. What family has God laid on your heart to pray for?

ADULTS

► Prayer:

When July 1 comes, we have 19 days leading up to the beginning of the annual National Convention. We ask that during that time, you earnestly pray that the Lord will move among His people, that business will go smoothly, and that lives will be changed during the preaching of His Word. Pray also that hearts will be stirred to act in the many breakout sessions taking place. Pray specifically for the families and kids who will engage with our missionaries and staff members who can share more about God's global mission.

► Activity:

Download the convention program so you can be praying specifically for the seminars, speakers in the services, students serving, events or gatherings, and other activities. Perhaps this will help you to decide to go to the 2027 National Convention – there's something for everyone!

TEENS/YOUTH

▶ **Memorize Scripture:** Matthew 28:18-20

These verses in Matthew give us clear direction on God's calling on our lives, no matter our age. We don't outgrow the responsibility of leading others to Christ. Memorize three verses to guide you throughout your life as a believer who lives on mission.

▶ **Devotion:**

You're commissioned – yes, YOU! Commissioned means you are formally authorized, ordered, or appointed to perform a specific task or produce a piece of work. Our verses clearly tell us what Christ wants us to do. Look around you, at your school, in the park, playing sports. The nations are coming to us. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you as you build relationships with other teens – hang out with them, play sports together, sit with them at lunch. He will help you at the right time as you share your faith with them. Think about and pray for each IM Missionary who has answered the call to leave all behind and serve Christ in other parts of the world and in the United States.

▶ **Prayer:**

Take this month to also be aware of the people who are around you. Do you have new neighbors? Help them move in. Is there a new kid in your youth group or Sunday School class? Have him/her sit with you at lunch. Sometimes the first thing to do in discipling and sharing Christ with others is to just be aware of needs. In July, our National Convention theme this year is FOCUS – this month, pray for opportunities to share the Good News and focus on ways you can focus on others around you.

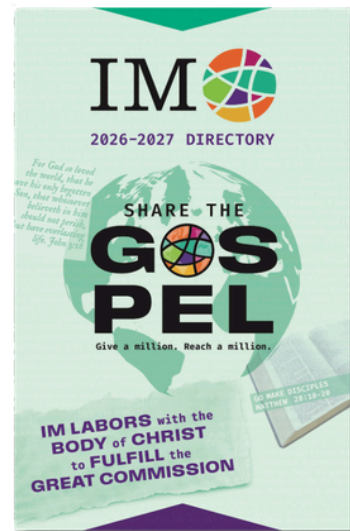
TEENS/YOUTH

KIDS

➤ **Memorize Scripture:** Matthew 28:19

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,” (Parents, abbreviate verse 19 for smaller children.) Jesus told us to do this, and we should do it gladly! We want others to know about Jesus, and we want them to come to church with us. Let’s memorize this verse this month!

➤ **Devotion:**

Do you remember the song, “Jesus Loves the Little Children”? The song says, “He loves all the children. Red, yellow, black, and white. They are precious in His sight.” When we look at our school, on the playground, in the parks, and while playing sports, we see all colors of children, and Jesus loves every one of them. He wants us to tell them how much He loves them. What are some ways you can share how Jesus loves them? You can treat others kindly, you can invite someone to come sit with you, you can help them with their school work. Ask your parents for other ways you can share Jesus.

➤ **Prayer:**

Pray, “Jesus, help us to tell others about You. Help us to be kind and give us ways to show Your love to others. We pray for our missionaries who are telling people all over the world about You. We know there are boys and girls who are sharing the Good News to others and we pray for them.

KIDS

► Activity:

Here's a fun craft as you share the Good News of Jesus.

- 1) Cut out hearts from construction paper.
- 2) Cut out smaller hearts from magazines or newspapers that have words.
- 3) Write: Good News! Jesus Loves You! (You might even draw something.)
- 4) Glue the smaller hearts onto the bigger hearts.
- 5) Let it dry.

Hang these somewhere in public or pass them out to your friends.
