What is it?

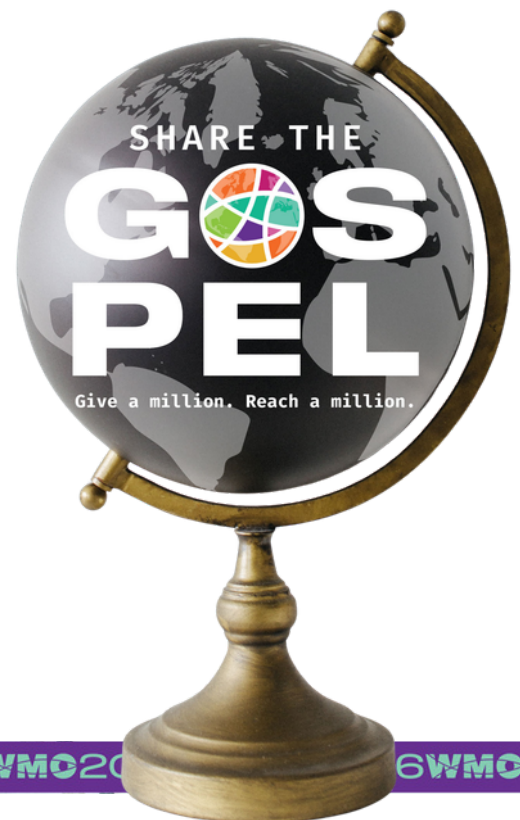
The IM Missions Moment creates a designated time to focus on a missional topic, paired with Scripture, a devotional thought, and an activity or object lesson. Each month, as a church or family, you can download the featured Missions Moment PDF for the corresponding month and use any of the material to center your heart and congregation around missions.

Why participate?

When you take time to memorize Scripture, pray regularly for missionaries and partners, and do missions-themed activities, you are actively involved in the Great Commission, which was commanded by Jesus to all believers (Matthew 28).

Who is it for?

We would encourage your church's missions director, pastor, or a designated volunteer to take ownership of leading your congregation through this material monthly. Whether you're in college, single, or have a family, you can commit to participating in each month's focus. You'll find age-specific content for each Missions Moment, so use what fits you or your audience. The content and material are intended for you to adapt and use in your own context.





How to use it

The material is versatile and can be adapted in several ways to fit your church and life routines.

Here are a few ways you can use this content (these are just suggestions, not the only ways):

- Monthly WAC group meet-ups
- Kids'Corner with your pastor
- Sunday School class material
- Youth night
- Saturday morning as a family
- In the evening, as a young single or college student
- Missions moment Sunday morning service
- Homeschool lesson for the month

► **Focus: Make an IMpact**

ADULTS

► **Memorize Scripture:** Romans 15:26-27

Spend this month memorizing these two verses. They are pivotal for seeing how helping fellow believers in need is Gospel-centered.

► **Devotion:**

You'll see several charities that want to help people in times of need. There are many great ones. But it is the Church that offers hope through giving.

At IM, we often present the needs of our missionaries and partners through IMpact Projects, which offer you specific ways to help in various areas. Perhaps it's a vocational school, updating medical equipment, or church building projects. Your money goes directly to that purpose. By giving, you're connecting with that local community and contributing to the set goal.

In Cuba, one of the countries where IM Global Partners ministers, churches are no longer permitted to be built. So the local believers are buying houses to convert into places of worship. Right now, they need 20 houses to serve throughout the country. Your donation to that project goes directly to that need.

Another IMpact Project is through JPense, an event hosted by IM missionaries and held in France. These events are held to specifically invite "seekers" and "skeptics" to come and hear the truth of the Gospel. And it's effective! Your donation to this project helps with rental space so that many people can attend and be reached with the Gospel.

Your faithfulness to one of these projects make it possible for many to be served, reached, and shown the love of Christ.

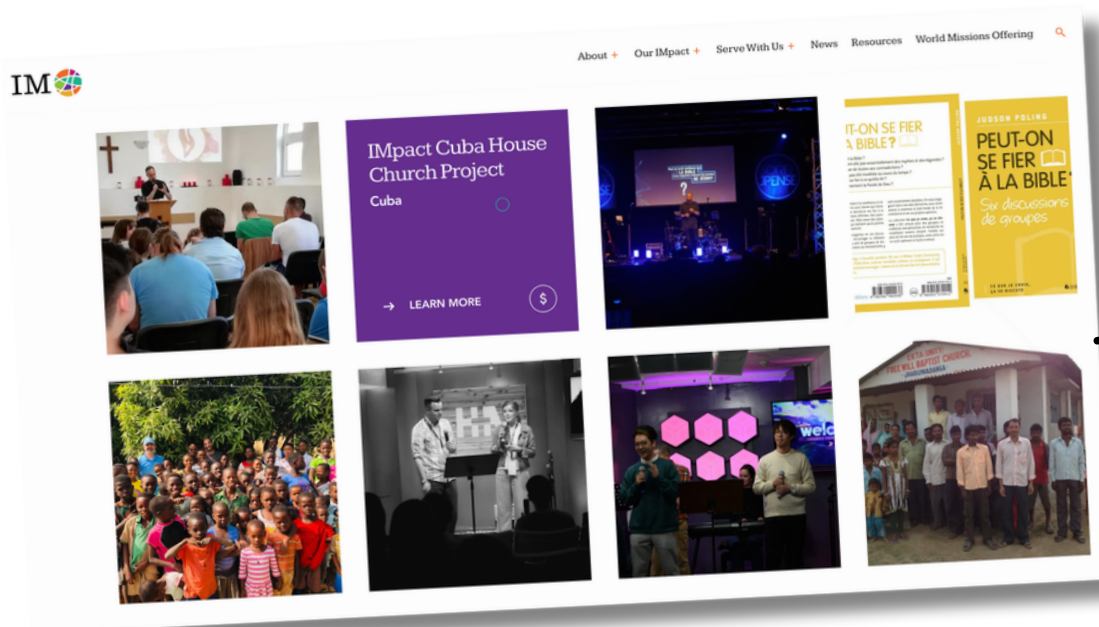
ADULTS

► Prayer:

In Romans 15:26 and 27, Paul encouraged Christians to make a contribution for “the poor among the saints at Jerusalem.” Not only did they do it, but they were pleased to do it. Pray for each of the Impact Projects being carried out in communities around the world where our missionaries and partnerships serve. Pray for other supporters who will give generously to these efforts.

► Activity:

Go to www.iminc.org and in the top menu, look under “Our Impact” and navigate to “Impact Projects” (pictured below). Scroll through this page to choose a project you would like to support and learn specific ways to pray. Read through the Impact Projects and see the various needs. ➤ **Memorize Scripture:** Romans 15:26-27

Spend this month memorizing these two verses. They are pivotal for seeing how helping fellow believers in need is Gospel-centered.

➤ **Devotion:**

YOU are the generation of today. YOU are rising up and claiming Christ as your Savior. YOU are going on mission trips. YOU are serving in your community.

YOUR generation is seeing the needs around you, and YOU are responding. Some studies show that your generation is meeting needs better than older generations. There are many ways to contribute to needs in your community; thank you for giving and serving where you live.

There are needs around your community, but also around the world. We want to invite you to consider the ways you can participate in what God is doing at IM around the world: mission trips, the World Missions Offering, missionaries, partnerships, and projects.

➤ **Prayer:**

Our verses this month remind us how early Christians were pleased to donate to “the saints in Jerusalem who were suffering.” They realized that it was an honor to share in the spiritual blessings as well as material blessings. See if you can memorize these two verses—practice daily as you pray.

TEENS/YOUTH

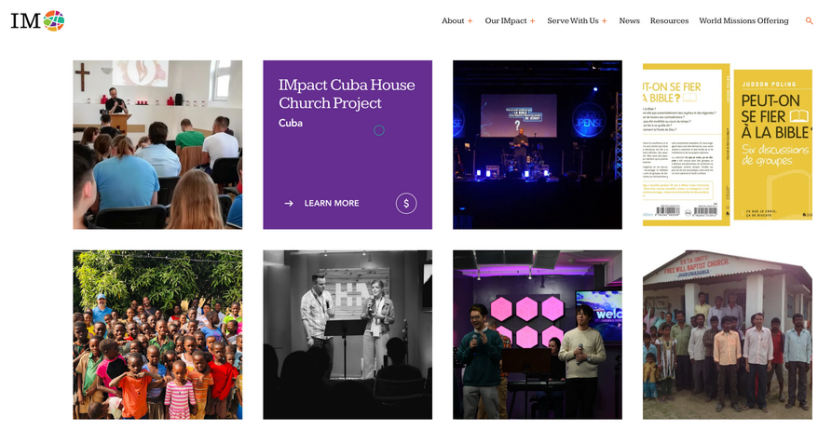
► Activity:

This month, we would like to challenge you to give to one of IM's Impact Projects around the world. Any amount that you give goes 100% to that need. Go to www.iminc.org and in the top menu, look under "Our Impact" and navigate to "Impact Projects" (pictured below). Scroll through this page to choose a project you would like to support and learn about that interests you (invite a friend or your Sunday School class to join you).

Print out one Impact Project and place it in your room, or keep on your phone, so you can remember to pray for the project daily. If you're on social media, make sure you follow IM (@imincorg) to keep up with projects and how their funding is progressing.

Save up for one month and be prepared to give to that project at the end of the month.

Once you've picked your Impact Project, use this **savings tracker sheet** on the next page (or scan the QR Code below) to see how you are saving. Set a goal and a deadline for giving. You can give through your church or directly online to IM (ask your parents to help you or visit www.iminc.org/give). More than giving, we want you to pray for those who are leading these projects and for those who will be impacted by these projects in the local communities.

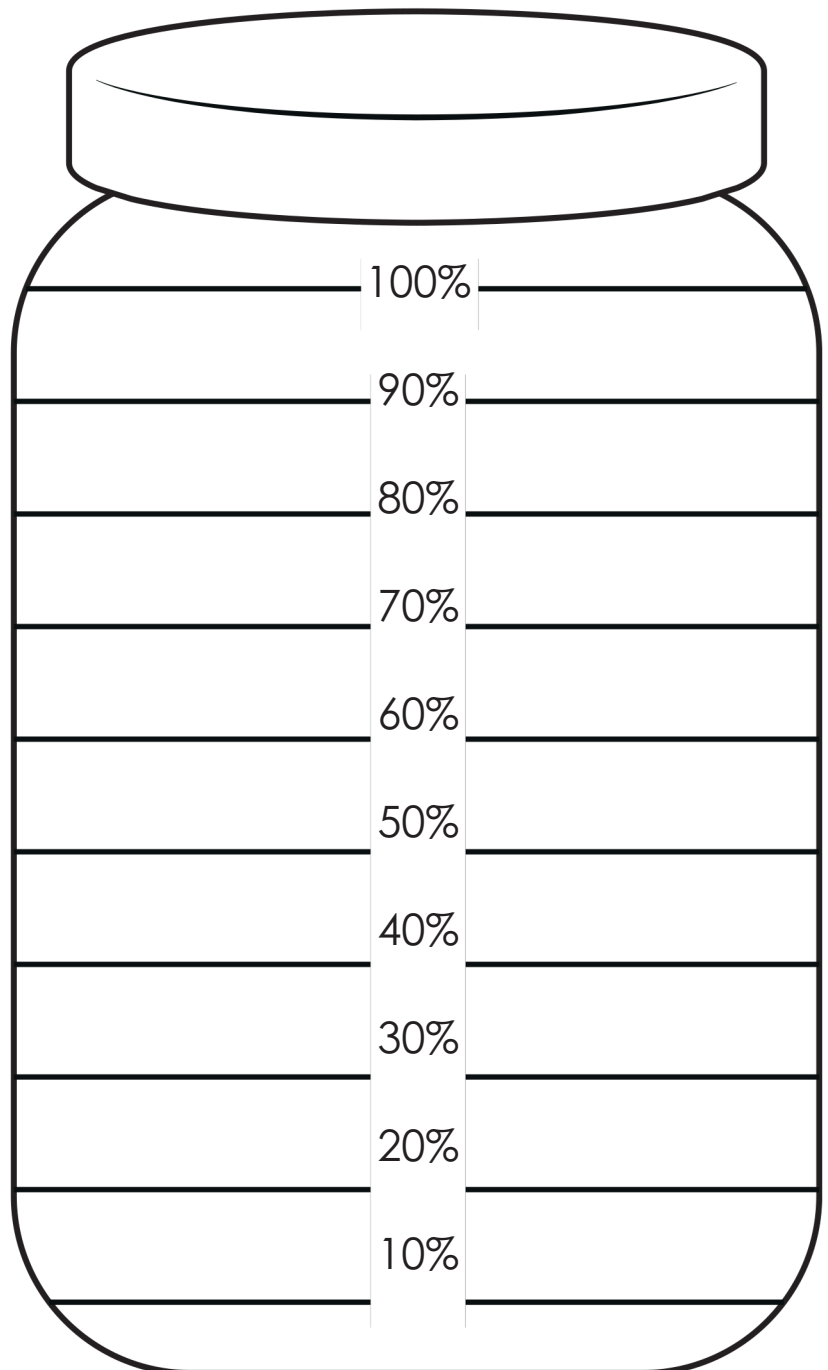

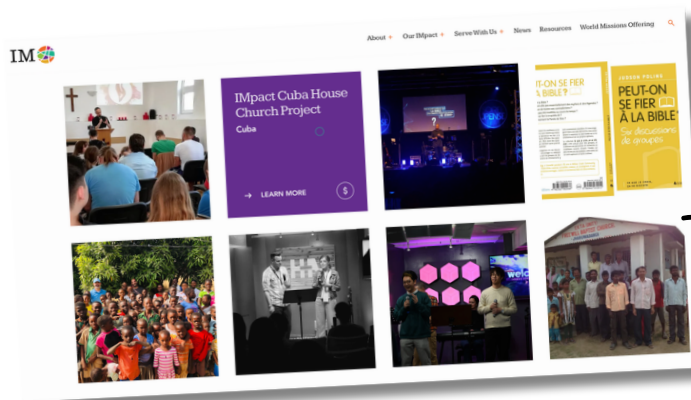
➤ **Memorize Scripture:** Romans 15:26-27

As believers in Jesus, we give to help others. And it's especially a joy to help other Christians. Our verses this month tell us that believers were so happy and pleased to help the Christians in Jerusalem who were suffering. This September, begin memorizing Romans 15:26, which says, "For Macedonia and Achaia have been pleased to make some contribution for the poor among the saints at Jerusalem."

➤ **Devotion:**

You see your mom or dad working on many projects around the house. Did you know there are many projects that take place in other countries of the world that help show people the love of Jesus? You can be a part of sharing Jesus with people through these projects, and the best part is, you don't have to leave your home to do it!

Scroll through this page to choose a project you would like to support and learn about that interests you. These projects meet the needs of people all around the world and provide ways to share Jesus in local communities.

KIDS

► Prayer:

Don't forget to pray! Have your parents print out a copy of the Impact Project you've chosen and pray for that project every day. What a great way to joyfully give to those in need of the Gospel of Jesus.

► Activity:

You'll need three jars (plastic or glass). Label them: **Spend**, **Save**, and **Give**. Ask your parents for extra jobs around the house, in the yard, or to sell something you have to earn some money.

Once you have earned some money, you and your parents can decide how much should go in each jar. Then see how quickly your amount rises in each jar throughout the month, and especially focus on the "give" jar's amount. At the end of the month, you can give that money to the Impact Project you've picked out by visiting the IM website or mailing in a check (parents can help in submitting the gift amount).
